Our call volume slowed for the month of February. 54 calls were close to the monthly average which is 58. Overall call volume is 141 well below last year at 174. A difference of 18%.

Response time for January was adjusted to 6:26, due to a technical issue. Response time for February was 7:28 a number that is a slightly higher than average. Weather was a significant factor.

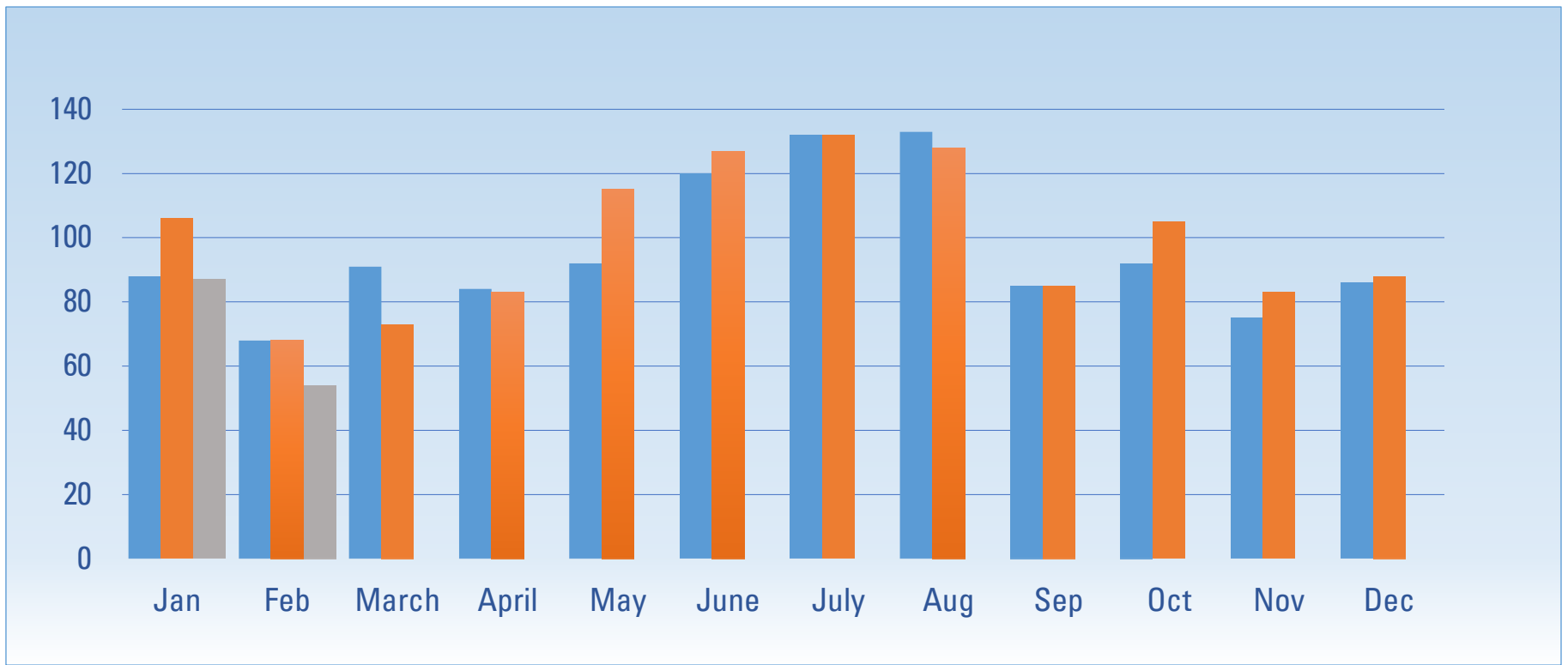

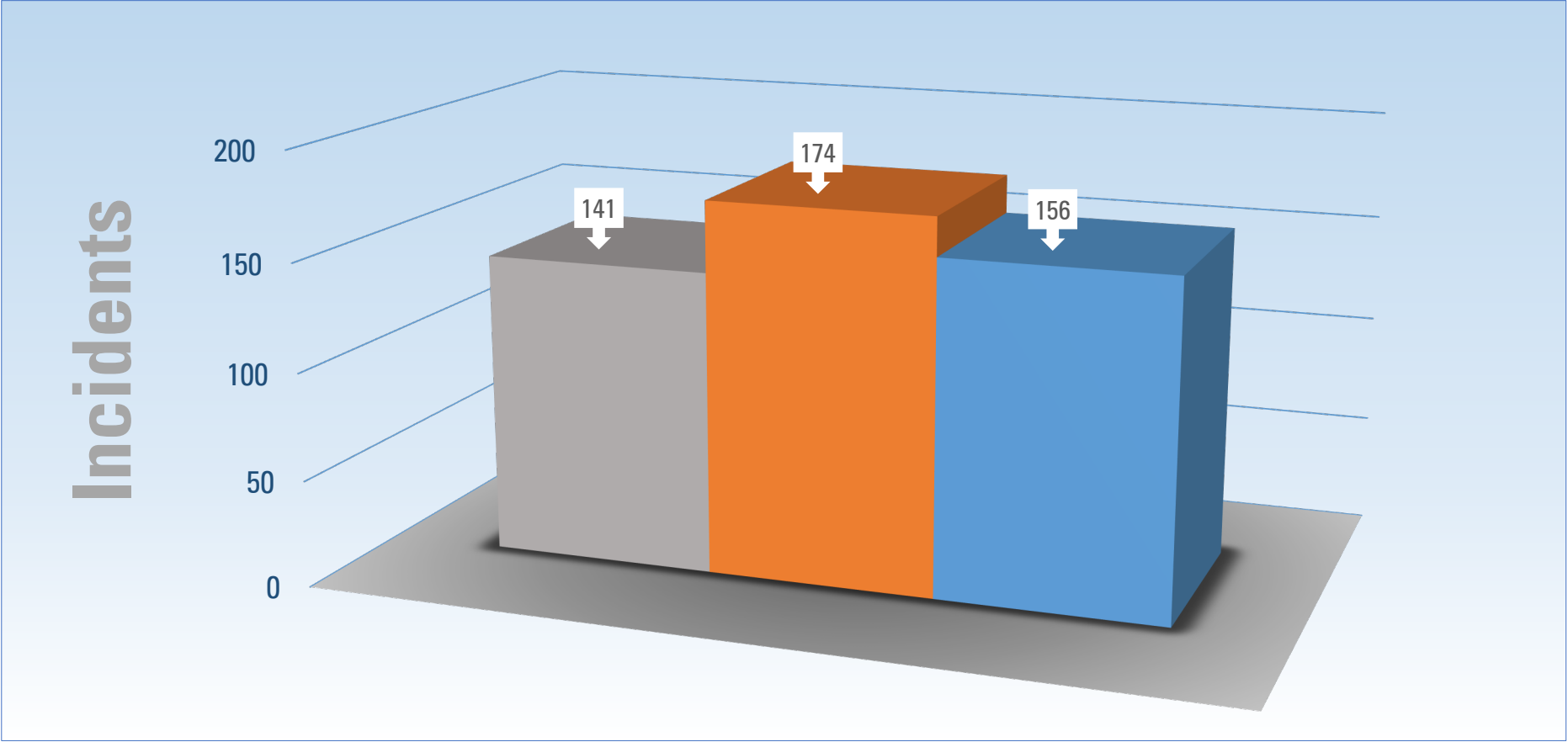

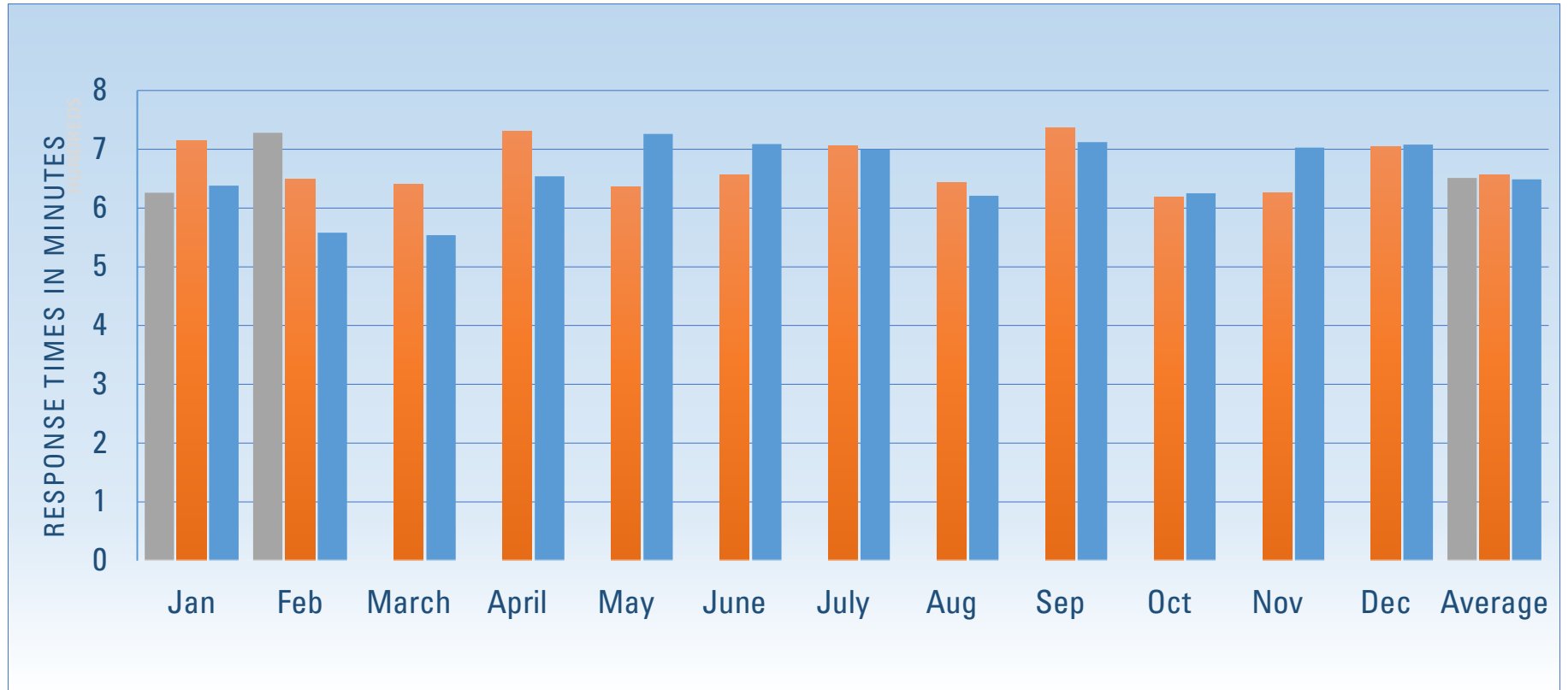

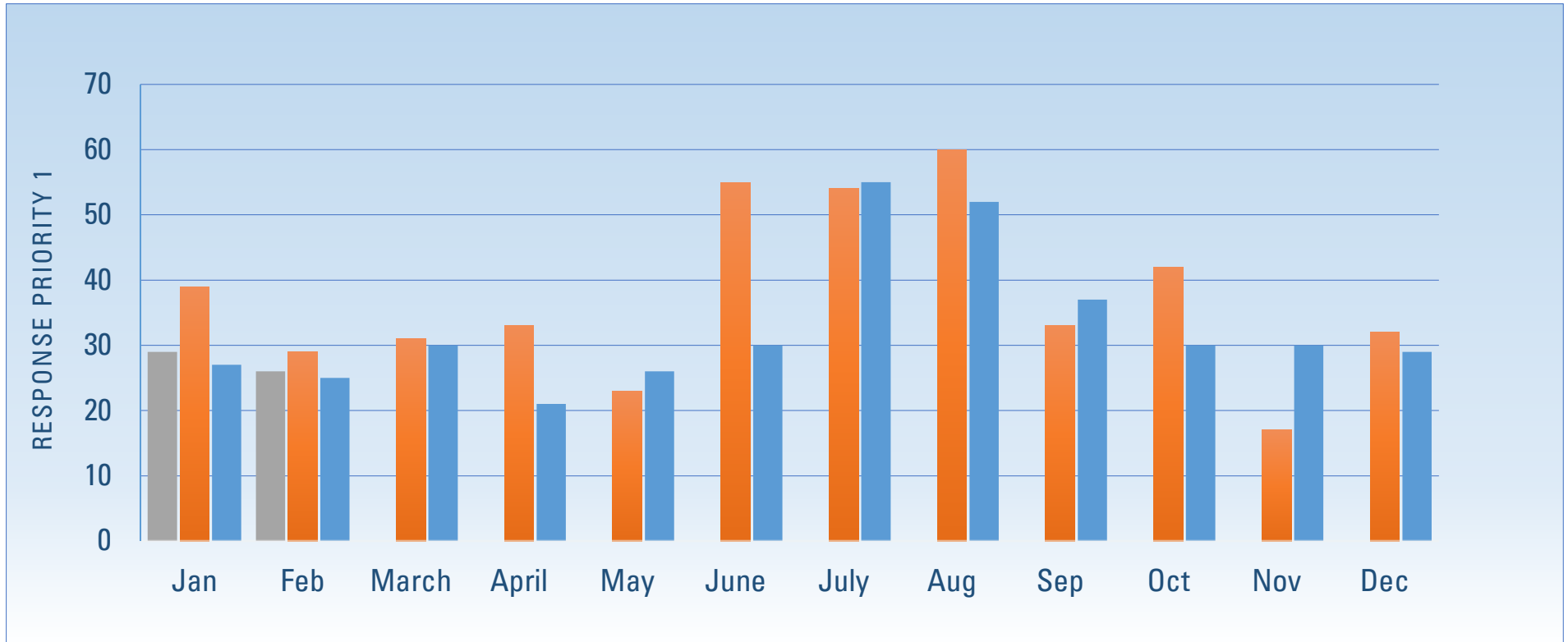

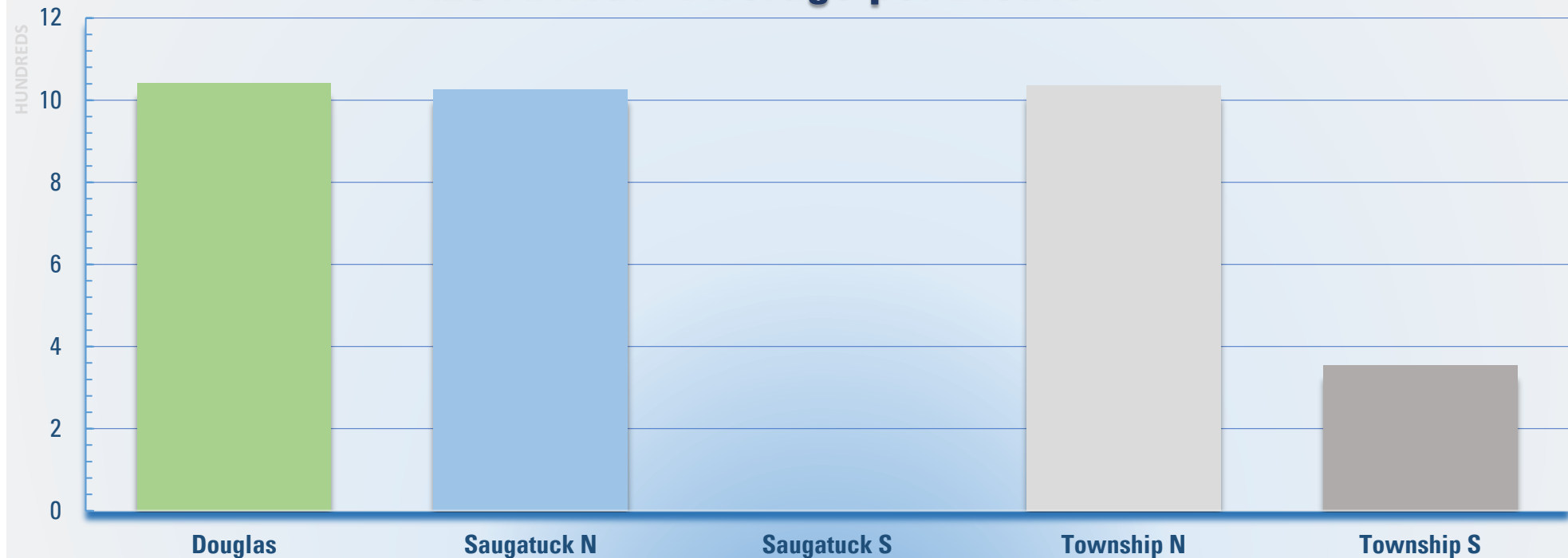

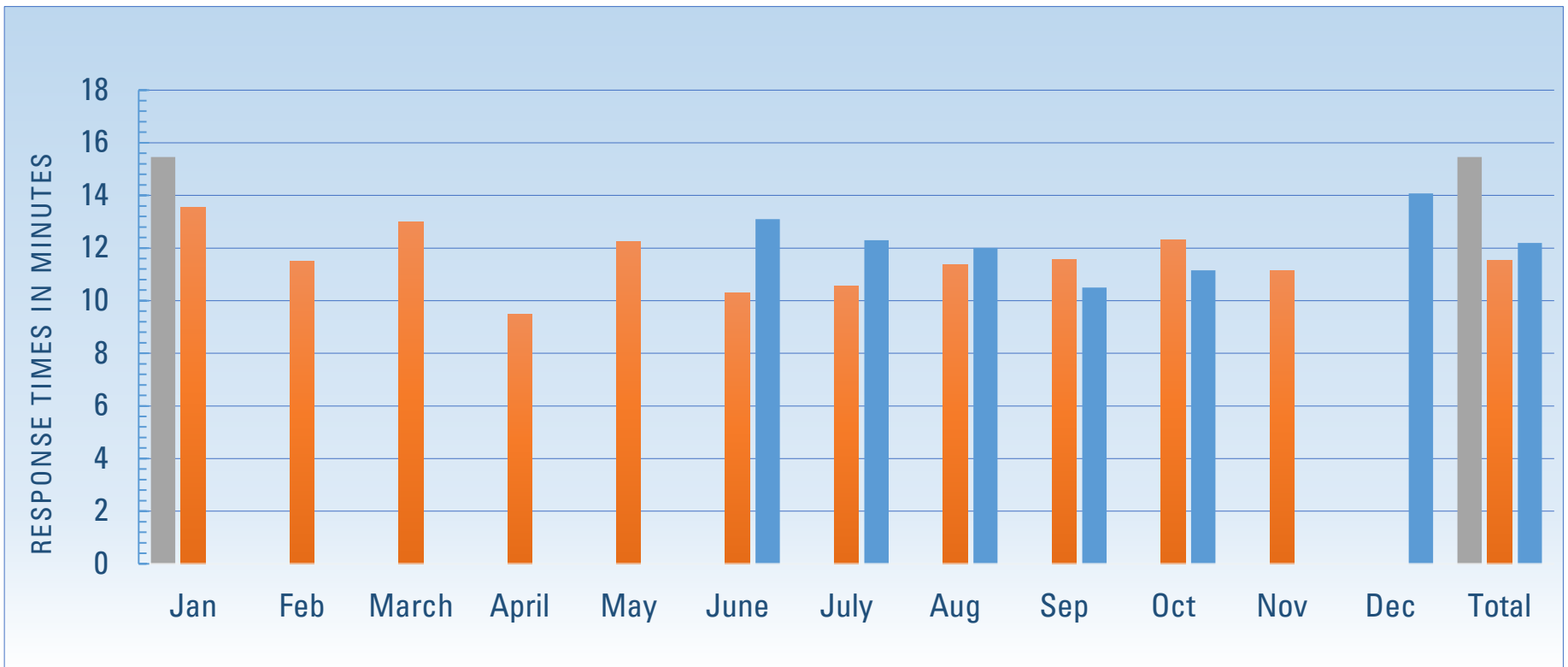
ALS Arrival - Average per District

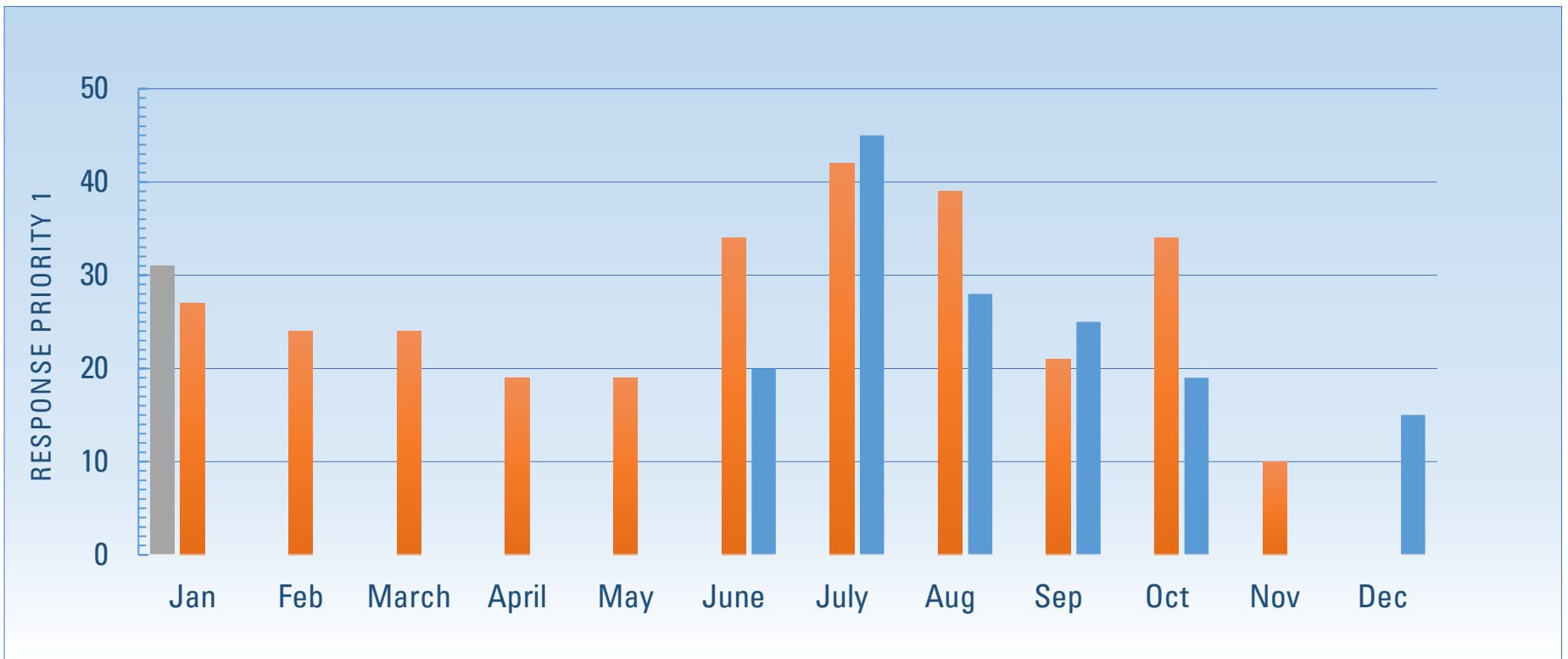

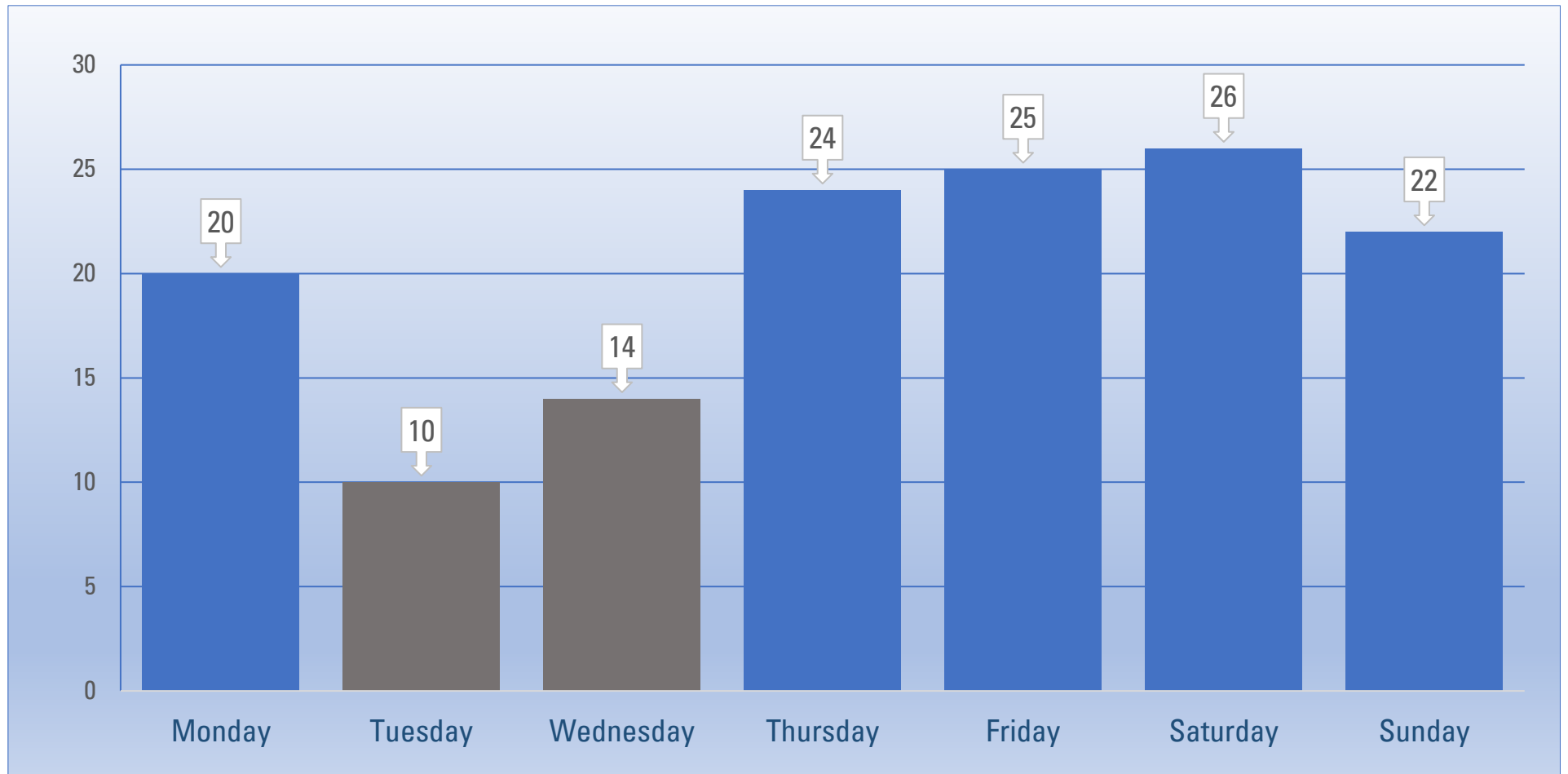

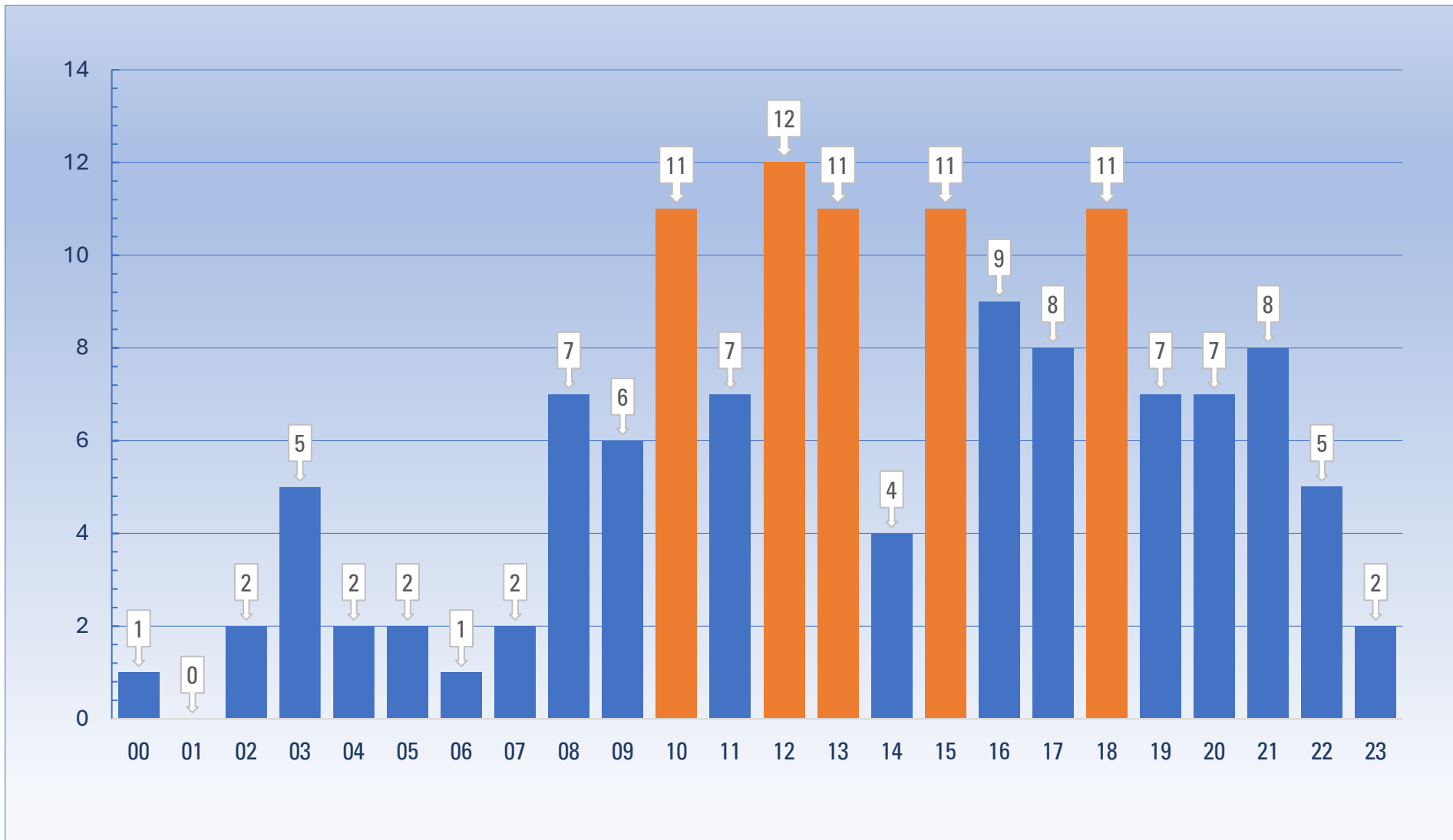


2026 Incidents per Day of the Week

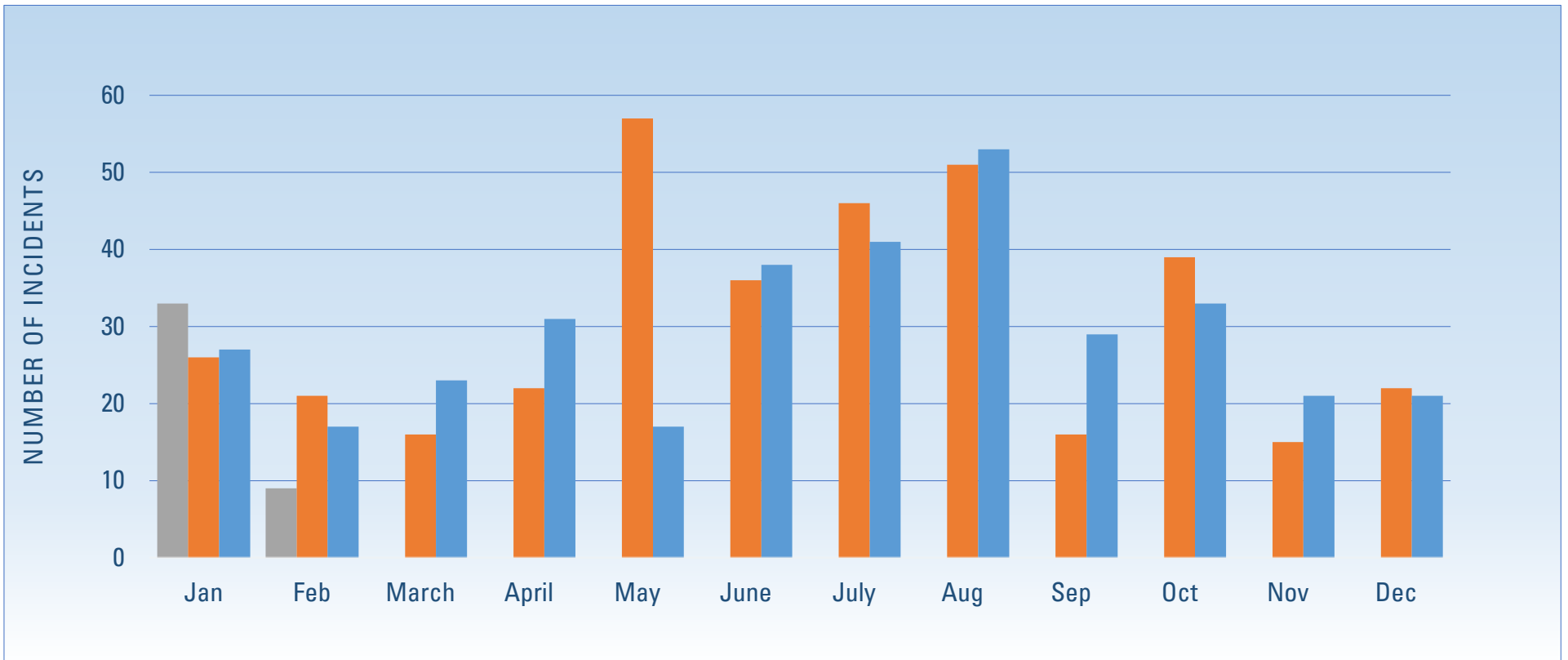
2026 Incidents by Time of Day

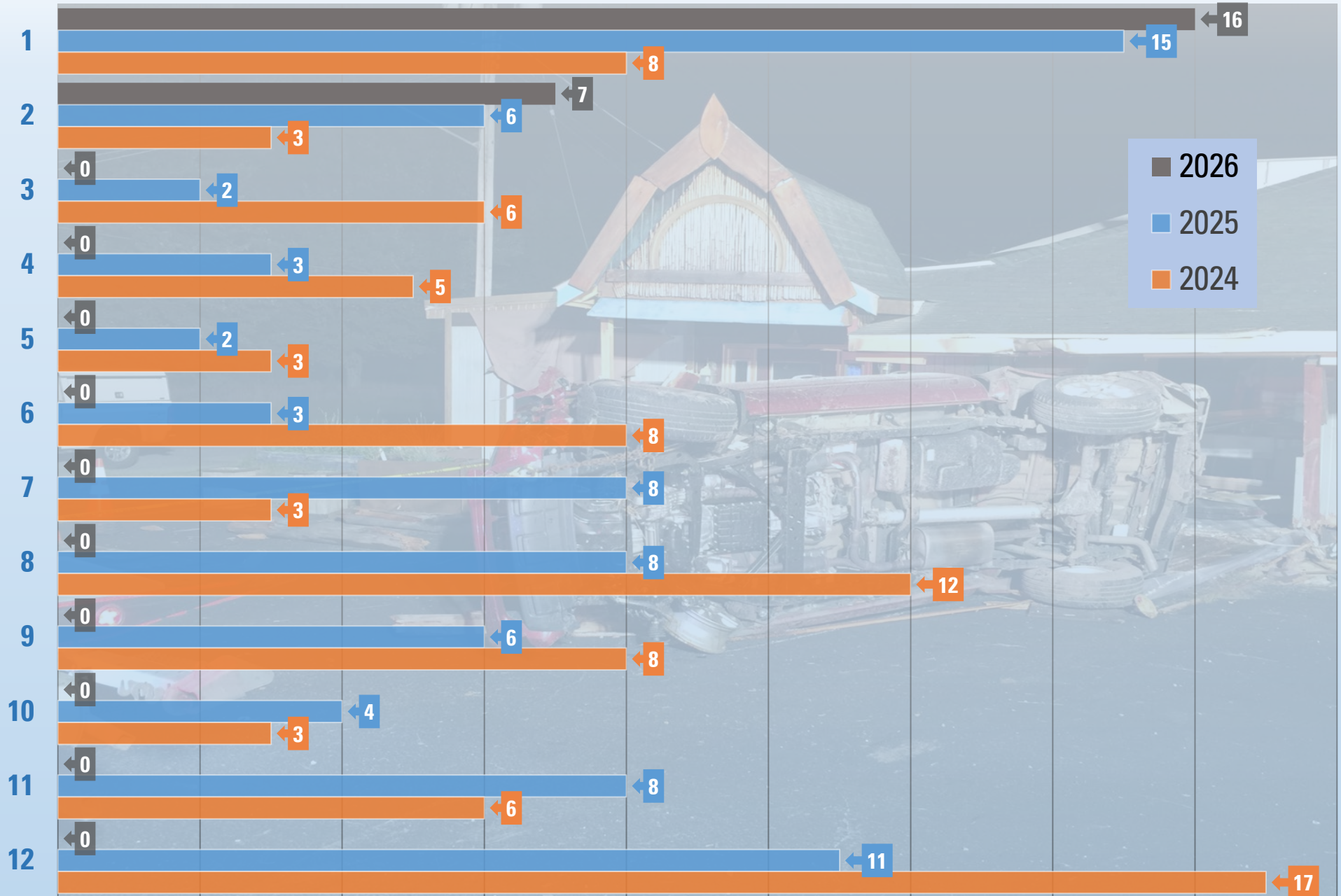

MV Incidents by Month 2022-2025



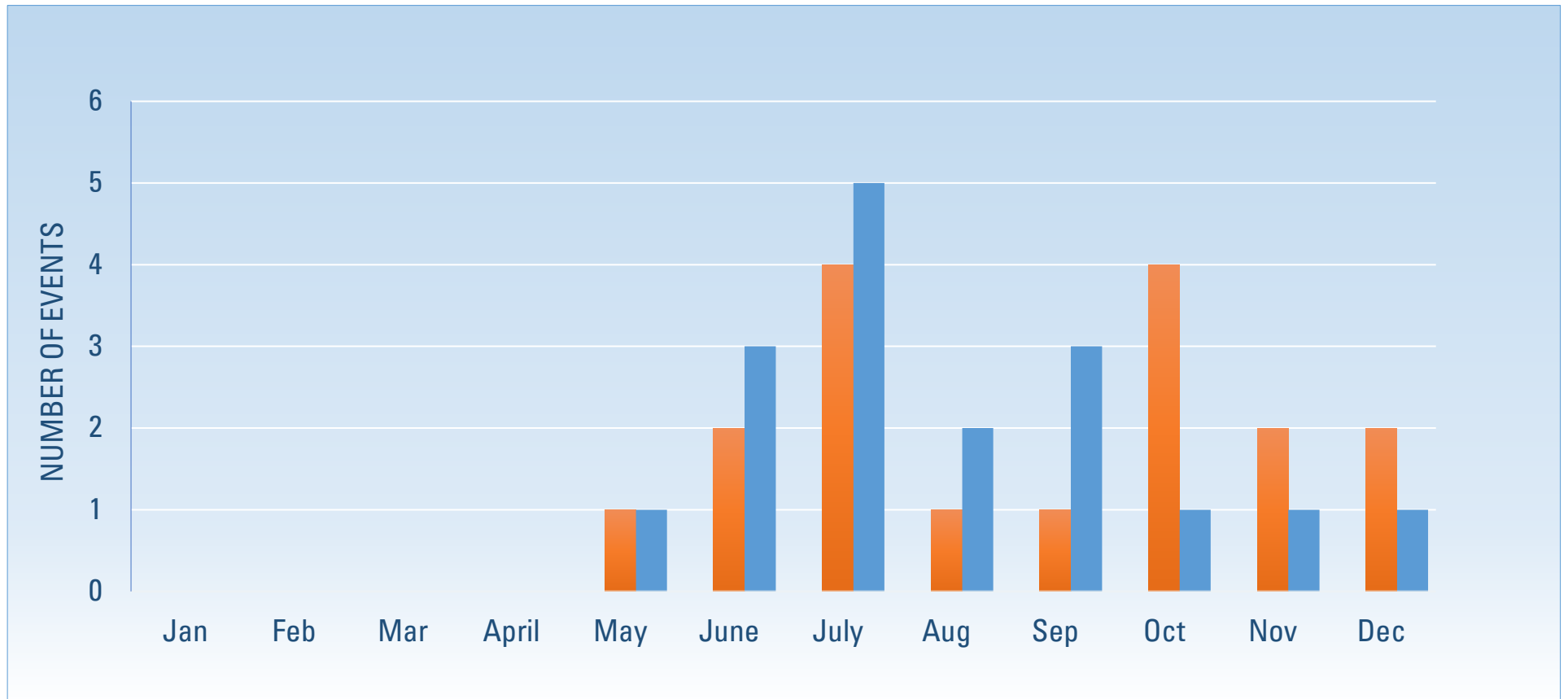

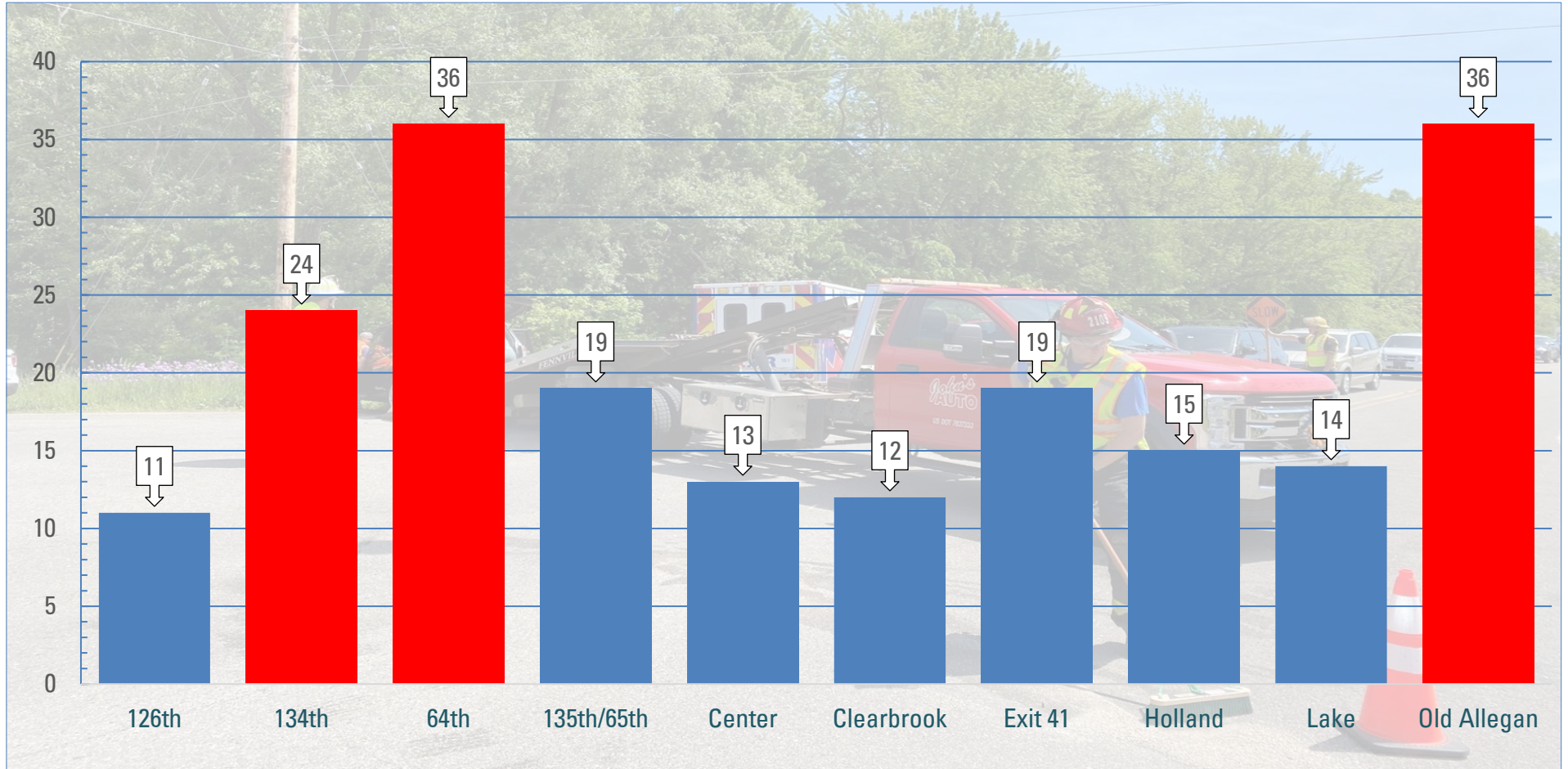
