CHIEF BLOK'S REPORT

- 1. Tiara can not haul new boat because of height. The height of the boat is 14 ½ feet. Kaye and Blok will investigate other haulers.
- 2. Reviewed First Responder requirements: "What an EMS Call Requires". (Priority 3 calls are less than 30 per year) Further discussion regarding question by Chris Roerig.
- 3. Confined space air unit is in.
- 4. Pickup repair is completed.
- 5. Fill station (SCBA) Bauer Air Compressor required maintenance with a cost of \$1,700 for new parts. Service from West Shore was insufficient and new company has been utilized.
- 6. Rick Zoulek update: Since initial conversation, no other contact was made even though Chief attempted it. Kaye talked for one hour with Rick. He believed that a leave of absence would be made. Topics discussed: survey, board member discussion and other areas were talked about. Rick has been discussed and it is still felt that personnel committee should meet with Rick. (The Chief set up a meeting with Rick on Friday, 2/21/03 and Rick did not show up).
- 7. We have two open fire officer positions. Four possible candidates are considered.
- 8. Grants money is becoming available and earmarked for equipment/some training. Key items described: fire and emergency resources, protective equipment, and communication. We will be looking for help in writing grants.
- 9. Maps submitted for Mutual Aide and agreements signed with Graafschap and Fennville. We will use these to increase our ISO rating.
- 10. Discussion of make-up and new structure of personnel committee to include a Fire Board representative and community member. **Motion by Kaye/Raebel to support expansion of personnel committee to include a community member and a Fire Board member.** Motion carried unanimously.
- 11. Motion by Kaye/Raebel to appoint Jerry Bekken as Fire Board representative to the personnel committee. Motion carried unanimously.

There being no further business, **Motion by Kaye/Asbel to adjourn at 9:10 p.m.** Motion carried unanimously.
