## SAUGATUCK TOWNSHIP FIRE DISTRICT BOARD MEETING MARCH 24, 2003

A workshop meeting of the Saugatuck Township Fire District was held on Monday, March 24<sup>th</sup>, 2003 at the Fire Station. The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m.

## CHIEF BLOK'S REPORT

- 1. Bill Kaye provided a letter due to his absence.
- 2. Fire Boat (item #2 on Bill's letter). Launch new boat first, hold old boat before selling until new boat is tested. Chief estimates a \$2,000 budget for putting boat in service with appropriate radios and miscellaneous equipment. Transportation costs were \$2,160, purchase price was \$2,500. Motion by Raebel/Edgcomb to offer for sale the River Queen Fire Boat either complete as a fire boat or as a pleasure boat with fire equipment removed, once the department is satisfied with the performance of the new boat, tentatively by July. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Raebel/Bekken to allow a budget not to exceed \$3,000, without further board approval, for the purpose of equipment and diesel inspection and initial start-up expenses for the new boat. Motion carried unanimously.
- 3. Board will respond to Bill Reed's letter. The Local Observer newspaper contacted Chief Blok and said Reed's resignation will be in the paper the week of March 26. **Motion by Raebel/Asbel to consult with attorney Bill Coupe to determine what board action may be recommended.** Board will wait for attorney response and discuss whether there is a need for a special meeting. Motion carried unanimously.
- 4. Review of by-laws in regards to Fire Chief, Article V: Fire Chief shall be responsible for all phases of Fire Department operations.
- 5. The following topics will be discussed at the April 3<sup>rd</sup> 9<sup>th</sup> fire meeting:
  - a. Clarify chain of responsibilities and educate department members in department management.
  - b. Discuss how the incentive program works.

There being no further business, Motion by Raebel/Asbel to adjourn at 9:00 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
