## CHIEF BLOK'S REPORT

- 2. The River Queen has been sold and all fire equipment is being removed. The closing should be done in a week.
- 3. The Janik family has donated another \$1,000 toward the Donation Fund.
- 4. We are receiving information on the Cummins engines that are for sale for \$1,000 each. A deposit of \$500 has been sent in to hold engines.
- 5. We have an offer on the ladder truck for \$5,000, which the board does not feel is adequate. The board agreed to counter offer, as there are other interested parties.
- 6. We are still committed to sell the Squirt.
- 7. The engine has been reinstalled in the boat and has been started. The board wants the boat to be in the water soon and keep in as long as possible.
- 8. At the township meeting, it was discussed to use the funds from the sale of the River Queen plus additional funds towards air packs. This will be a Fire Board decision.
- 9. We will investigate details of engine work performed on the boat. Joe Fucile showed a manual and pump parts to the board.
- 10. The AIS bill for rebuilding the water pump and bearings will be checked by the Fire Board.

There being no further business, Motion by Raebel/Kaye to adjourn at 8:25 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
