Chief Blok's Report:

Bill Kaye, Chairman

- 1. Fire calls are even with last year at this time.
- 2. Need to get ready for new budget. Discussions for any changes in insurance. Timetable for budget presentation was submitted.
- 3. Discussion as to who would work on the budget. It was decided that it would be Lance and Jerry.
- 4. Discussion of ISO ratings, further reductions would be difficult. Maintaining the present rating of 5 is the best goal.
- 5. Discussion of old tanker (which is 20 years old) and replacement. Another tanker is \$133,000.
- 6. Newest pumper is 15 years old and we should be budgeting for another pumper in the next two years.
- 7. Pagers are high repair item. Newest pager is 1996. Motorola stopped making parts and new pagers are \$370 each. We should start to budget for replacement.
- 8. Back station air compressor is needed, \$600.
- 9. Hose bridge for protection of hose laid across the roadway.
- 10. Getting an estimate from the Chief for coating bottom of fire boat.
- 11. Talk regarding lack of personnel who drive stick shift and hose truck.
