#### **MINUTES**

To allow for the increase it was decided to eliminate the increases for Board Members, at the suggestion of the Chief hold the increase for the Chief to \$1,000, and reduce several expense items.

#### **Chief Blok's Report:**

- 1. Tanker truck slated for purchase this summer will experience a price increase of \$7,000 June 1<sup>st</sup>. Board discussed placing an order prior to the price increase. Moved by Bekken, seconded by Winchester to order a Tanker Truck with Cummins power for \$116,719. Carried unanimously. Blok stated the purchase will be through the same vendor that built the last truck.
- 2. Board addressed the proposed budget. Moved by Smith, seconded by Bekken to approve the proposed budget with amendments as presented earlier. Carried unanimously.
- 3. Discussion took place regarding cost recovery procedures. Costs from the recent fires will be recovered through insurance payments.
- 4. Blok discussed several items being bid out by the same government agency the department purchased the fire boat through.
