 - o Will be holding a First Responder school for the 4 new Firefighters that were recently added.
 - Chief is also encouraging other Firefighters currently on the roster that are not First Responders to get certified. Final count not known for sure at this time.
- Saugatuck Public School:
 - O Chief met with new Superintendent (Rolf Timmerman) and the Chief is happy to note that DPS is willing to cooperate with him and his staff. NOTE: the school has not been inspected by STFB for about 5 years!
 - o DES principal (Teya Lober) stopped by to introduce herself to the Chief.
- Ford Pickup
 - Investigated the "Cash for Clunkers" offer but the truck was too old.
 - Chief will continue to keep his eye out for a used pickup that will work with our budget.

Board Concern:

The Old Broward building has not been inspected as of this meeting. Chief is working on the situation with Saugatuck Township.
