A. Review and Approval of Minutes:

- i. **Minutes 12/10/12:** Motion to approve by Phelps, 2nd by Bekken, passed unanimously

- v. **State Purchase Program:** Chief explained the program and it shows significant cost saving when purchasing vehicles.

- vii. **Mini Pumper:** We plan on replacing 2 vehicles; Rescue 1 and Engine 2 with this vehicle. We will use the proceeds from the sale of these vehicles for the down payment.
