- 7. Special Guest Speaker Audit Review
  - A. Dan Veldhuizen of Siegfried Crandall P.C.
    - 1. Chief Janik and P. Stanislawski do an excellent job of being fiscally responsible for the Saugatuck Township Fire District's assets and are great to work with.
    - 2. Dan reviewed key points of the Audit and subsequent letter.
    - 3. Dan stated Peter does a great job managing the new requirements for pension reporting.
    - 4. Overall financial statement is in good order. The fund balance at 60% is healthy, and certainly not excessive.
    - 5. Net Pension liability is \$94,000, which is about 80% funded or a good position to be in.
    - 6. The District has done an excellent job with budget variances throughout the year.

  - 3. No other agencies have escrow accounts, they accept a fee upon application.

The Fire service is no longer looked at as "dysfunctional" in the county and is now being asked to participate on project discussions for equipment such as MCT's.
- B. E. Beckman discussed the 135<sup>th</sup> Street project status. Aldrich stated the watermain discussion will likely continue with the new manager.
- C. S. Aldrich stated that the new Township Manager/Zoning Administrator will start February 4th, 2019.
