  - A. Incident Reports / Calls to Date / Overlapping Calls
    - 1. Incident report statistics year to date were reviewed 222 incidents year to date.
    - 2. 5:19 average response time year to date.
  - **B.** Community Risk Reduction
    - 1. State of Michigan experienced 57 fatal fires year to date for 2020, 17 since last meeting.
    - 2. Had three structure fires in the past 10 days, and all of them were awakened by smoke alarms. The one at 1:30am this morning had smoke alarms that were installed by the Fire District as part of a smoke alarm blitz.

#### 11. New Business:

- A. Insurance Services Office (ISO) Survey Results
  - 1. ISO survey results were reviewed by Chief Janik using maps created by D.C. Mantels. Our previous survey was in 2013, and ISO changed their rating format to split ratings in 2014. Beginning in 2014, any property that is located more than 5 miles from a responding fire station, receives a 10 rating automatically. The Fire District used to be a straight 5 PPC rating, and now received a 4/10 PPC rating. Our score lowered for much of the District, and one small area of Lakeshore Drive from the Washout to approx. 126<sup>th</sup> Ave will be a 10 PPC rating due to distance. Not all insurance companies use ISO services, so it is possible not all properties in the affected area will notice a change. Possibly make a future recommendation to Township board regarding water supply and access road for that area.
