  - i. Financial report reviewed by P. Stanislawski.
    - 1. Engine 2112 2011 KME Final Truck payment is made.
- 9. Fire Chief Comments:
  - A. Incident Reports / Calls to Date / Overlapping Calls
    - 1. Incident report statistics year to date were reviewed 101 incidents year to date.
    - 2. 6:54 average response time year to date
  - B. Community Risk Reduction
    - 1. State of Michigan experienced 10 fire fatalities in 9 fires year to date for 2021.
  - C. Paid on Call Employees
    - 1. Brad Esquivel New Hire (In Academy currently)
    - 2. Kyle Trinklein New Hire (Certified FF/MFR from Fennville)
    - 3. Misty Sherer New Hire (Certified FF/MFR from Leighton)
    - 4. Phil Dalton Re-Hire (Certified FF)
    - 5. Bryan Kempkers New Hire (also serves as Deputy Chief/EMT on Hamilton Fire)
    - 6. Tom Dykstra New Hire (also serves as Captain/EMT on Graafschap Fire)

Chief discussed the hiring of new paid on call employees. The benefits both financially and operationally of hiring already trained personnel were discussed.

- D. Thank You's
  - 1. Lake Vista Supervalu Pallet of Bottled Water donated.
    - i. Chief thanked Lake Vista for another pallet of water. Bottled water is provided to STFD, Douglas PD, and Allegan Sheriff's.
- E. Grants
  - 1. MMRMA RAP Grant Submitted for Power Mirrors for Apparatus
  - 2. FEMA AFG Grant Submitted for Health and Wellness Program, Physical Examinations for all personnel, Immunizations in compliance with NFPA 1582, and Exercise Equipment to support the program. If awarded the \$40,290.00 the District 5% match will be \$2,014.50. Grant team of Chris Mantels and Chris Bernhardy managed to complete the grant on time, even with the time constraints caused by the IFC BOA, and Subpoena.
- F. Covid-19 Update
  - 1. State of Michigan Immunization dashboard was reviewed for the State, and Allegan County.
  - 2. Discussion ensued. If someone gets vaccinated in Ottawa County, it shows under Ottawa.





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#### 10. Unfinished Business:

- A. IFC BOA Decision / BOA Fees
  - 1. The IFC BOA denied the appeal, and upheld that the fire code official interpreted the code correctly.
  - 2. The BOA should review fee structure at next meeting, as it was determined to be a development, however they only paid single family fee.
- 11. New Business:
  - A. Equipment Disposal Request Genesis Hosed Tools (Roll Call Vote) Motion by Pullen, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Fox to authorize Fire District staff to execute an agreement with Overisel Township to sell the Genesis Hosed Extrication tool set including the power unit, cutters, spreaders, ram, and hoses, and to accept no less than \$19,000.00 for its sale. No discussion. YAYS: Pullen, Fox, Beckman, Phelps, Aldrich, Verplank NAYS: None ABSENT: Miller
    - Motion passes 6:0
  - B. Allegan County Groundwater Study Memo
    - 1. Memo was reviewed by Chief Janik.
    - 2. Beckman asked why the Fire District is involved in wells in the Township.
    - **3.** Chief Janik clarified that the District is required to be part of the wellhead protection district for KLSWA to obtain grants.
    - 4. Fox suggests we turn over to municipalities and let them worry about it.
  - C. Wage Study
    - 1. The ad hoc committee of Fox, Verplank, Phelps, & Stanislawski met twice. Discussing with consultants, MML, firms, it is difficult to have apples to apples comparable for Fire Departments wages. Human resources costs make up 58% of the budget.
    - 2. Requested to continue committee with replacing Verplank with Beckman, and adding an officer of command staff, preferably not Chief Janik.
    - 3. Revised wage study to include titles, responsibilities, certifications, salary ranges, date of hire, and current wages.
    - 4. Motion by Pullen, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Phelps to increase Chief Janik's wage effective immediately by 3%. No further discussion.
