Client Eligibility

Residents of Allegan County, aged 60 and older in need of supportive services to remain safely at home may be eligible to receive services in accordance to their need.

Service Focus

Eligibility criteria has been developed for each service to focus on the greatest social and/or economic need. The goals for service delivery are:

- Help older adults maintain their independence in the community
- Maximize delivery of services within the constraints of millage funds
- Exhaust all reasonable efforts to assess and provide services to any and all older adults eligible for millage services
- Collaborate with other social service agencies to deliver needed services
- Lessen the isolation of older adults

Allegan Senior Millage Services Defined

PERS

Personal Emergency Response System (PERS) buttons offer peace of mind and 24-hour response for any perceived emergency. Mobile wearable device.

Home Delivered Meals

Nutritious hot meals delivered to homebound seniors Monday-Friday.

Essential In-Home Supports

This service provides essential in-home services to keep older adults living safely at home. A care plan is developed that provides assistance with personal care (bathing, dressing, etc.) for the older adult, and/or in home respite for the caregiver as needed. Requests for this service begin with an in-home assessment to determine eligibility and develop an individualized plan of care based on the level of support needed.

**Hours are assigned appropriately to meet the individual support needed*

Adult Day Services

This service offers daytime care for seniors in need of continuous support & socialization. Program also provides needed respite for primary family caregivers.

Senior Transportation

Seniors who are no longer comfortable driving may access this service for non-emergency medical appointments to adjacent counties, non-medical appointments, shopping and errands. Depending on the mobility level of the senior, service can be provided on wheelchair friendly buses or with volunteer transportation where a volunteer drives the senior in their private vehicle.
